## Seeding Rates and Mowing Guide

| <b>Seeding Rate Guide</b>                             |                                     |
|---|-------------------------------------|
| <i>Turfgrass Species</i>                              | <i>Pounds per 1,000 Square Feet</i> |
| Perennial Rye,<br>(winter active varieties available) | 6-10                                |
| Tall Fescue (including dwarf types)                   | 10                                  |
| Kentucky Bluegrass                                    | 4-5                                 |
| Fine Fescues  | 5-6                                 |

| <b>Mowing Heights for General Turf Use</b>   |                             |

| Grass species differ in their durability, their disease resistance and their weather tolerance – which is why our geographical region supports many different grass varieties. Each species generally performs best at the following mowing heights, although recommended heights may vary with specific uses. |                             |
| <i>Cool Season Turf</i>  | <i>Ideal Mowing Heights</i> |
| Perennial Rye<br>(winter active varieties available)   | 1.5 – 2.5 inches            |
| Tall Fescue  | 3.0 inches                  |
| Kentucky Bluegrass   | 1.5 – 2.5 inches            |
| Fine Fescues   | 2.5 inches                  |
| <i>Warm Season Turf</i>  |                             |
| Bermudagrass   | 2.0 inches                  |
